SHOPPING LIST

materials needed:

1/4 yard x PATTERNED cotton fabric
1/4 yard x CONTRASTING cotton fabric
2kg rice or dried split peas

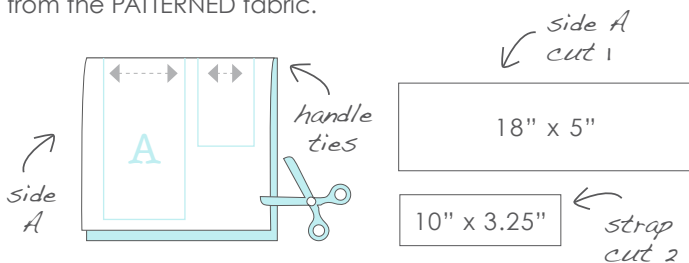
sewing notes:

All SEAMS are 1/2". All FABRIC in 44" – 45" bolts.

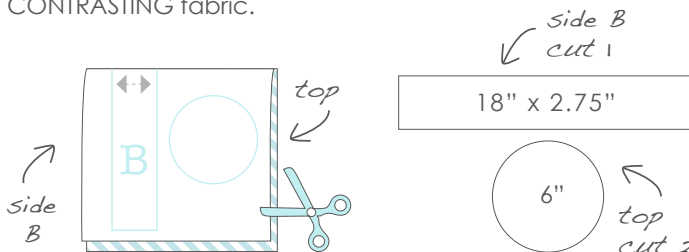
LET'S GET STARTED

cutting it out

1 Print and cut out the doorstop pattern pieces. Cut one 18" x 5" rectangle for the doorstop side A and two 10" x 3.25" rectangles for the handle ties. Cut both on the fold from the PATTERNED fabric.

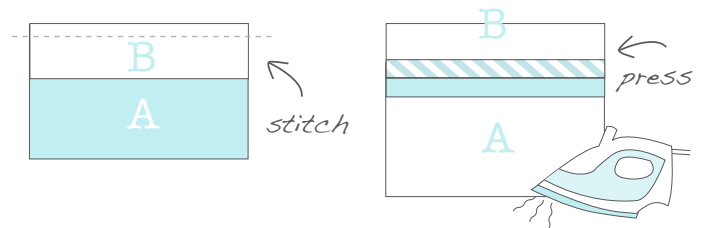


2 Now cut one 18" x 2.75" rectangle for the doorstop side B and two 6" circles for the top and bottom from the CONTRASTING fabric.

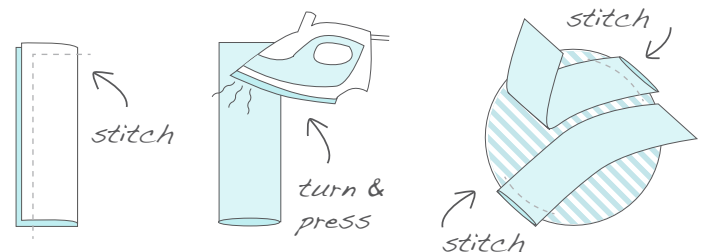


stitching it up

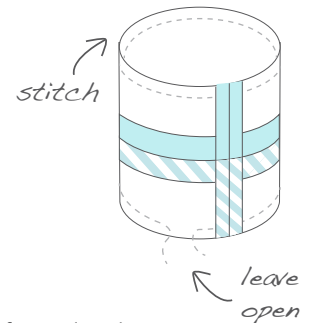
1 With **right** sides facing, stitch doorstop sides A and B together. Press seam allowances open.



2 Fold straps in half lengthwise and stitch down the side and across one end. Turn right side out and press. Tack unfinished ends to opposite sides of doorstop top.



3 Stitch side edges of the large rectangle together. Press seam allowances open. Pin and stitch side to top and bottom circles, leaving bottom seam open for turning through.



4 Turn right side out. Make a funnel out of paper and fill with rice or dried split peas. Stitch up gap in seam. Ta da! Your new decorative doorstop is complete. Let the sunshine in!
